



## About Us

We are a P&C based service located within Palmwoods State School. We are licensed for up to 75 children for each session.

## Our Commitment

We strive to provide a welcoming, fun environment for all children that attend our service and help them excel in all aspects of their development.



## Before School Care

We open at 6:30am for Before School Care. The areas we use in this session include, the room, the outdoor astroturf area, the hall and hall deck, and the oval. We provide breakfast throughout the morning session until 8:00am. Children can participate in a range of activities including arts and craft, reading, board games, construction, sensory activities, and dancing. At 8:20am areas are packed up and we get the children ready for school. Children in years 2-6 leave and go to the hall at 8:30am. The prep and year 1's stay until 8:40am where they are then walked to their classrooms by the educators.

## After School Care

The preps are collected from their classrooms by an educator at 2:45pm. At 2:50pm, during terms 1-3, the year 1's are collected from their classrooms by an educator. When the school bell rings at 2:50pm children from years 2-6 walk to Kids Club. The children put their bags away, wash their hands, then sit down and eat afternoon tea. Once afternoon tea is finished, children meet together for group time where they choose their areas for the afternoon. In the afternoon we use the oval, the playgrounds, the hall, under F block, the room, and the deck. Throughout the afternoon children can choose to move between the areas on offer.

## Vacation Care

We announce our Vacation Care Program a few weeks before the beginning of the holidays. In this program we have a range of activities, excursions, and incursions. Our ratio normally is 1:15, but on holidays it may be 1:10 or even lower, depending on the activity.
